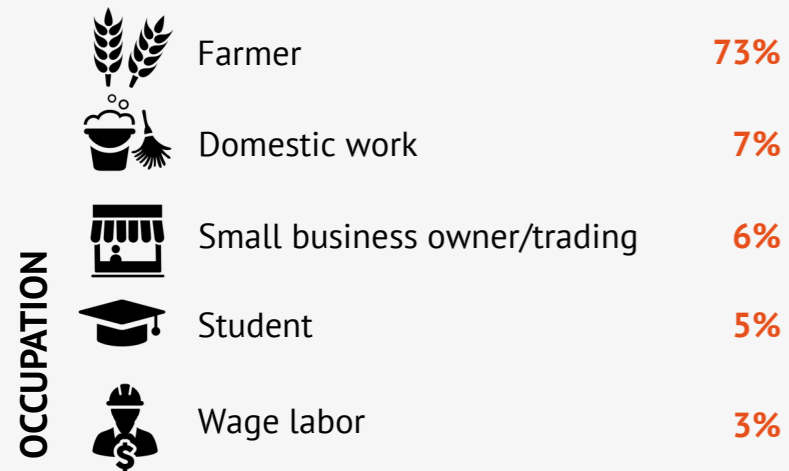

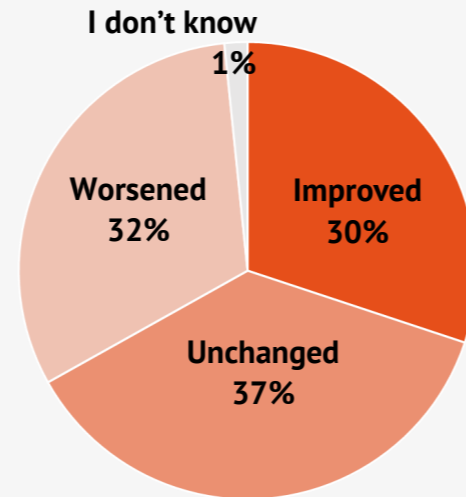

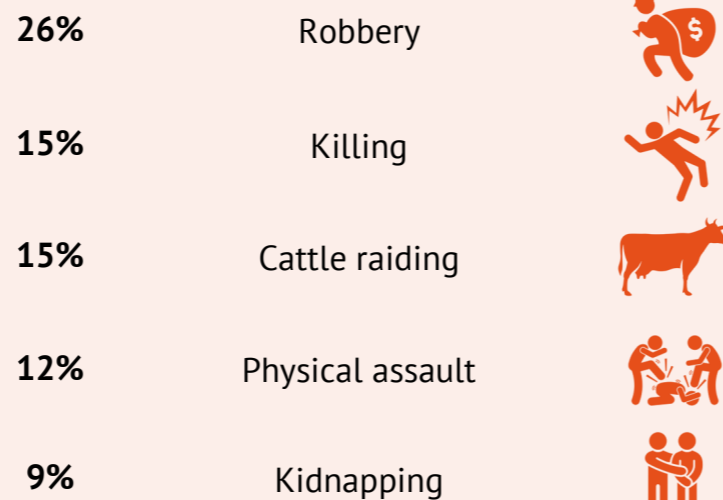

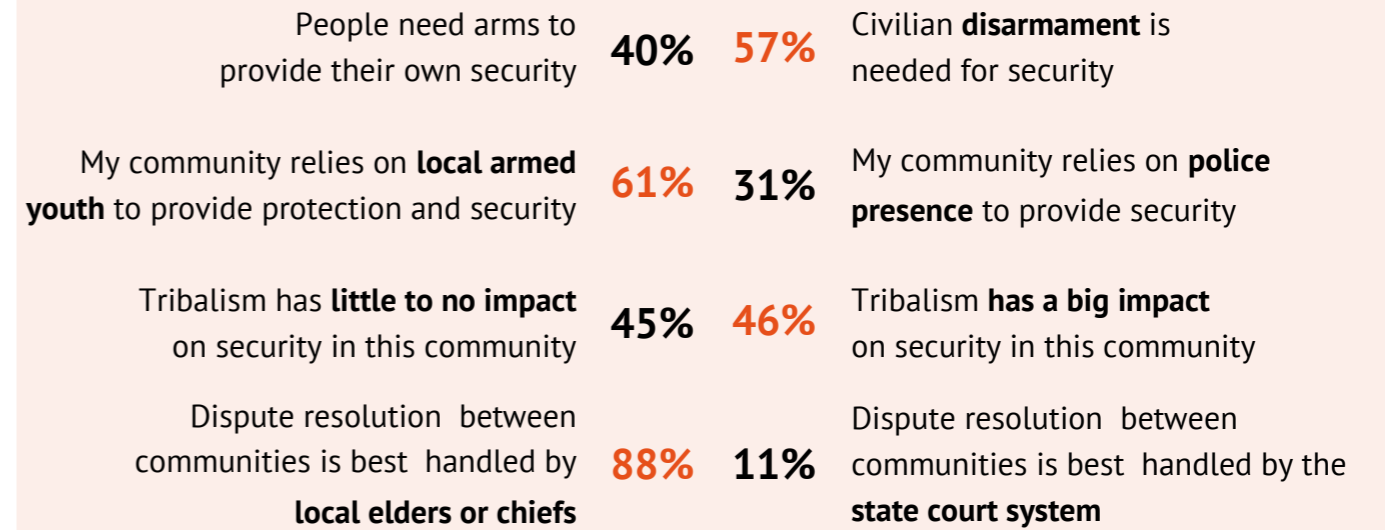

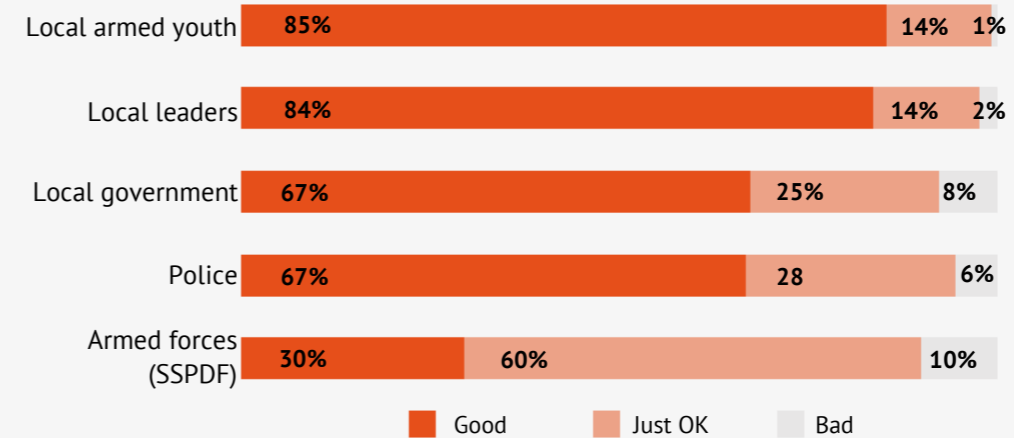
MOST FREQUENTLY REPORTED INCIDENTS (percentage of all 331 incidents)

HOW WOULD YOU RATE THE PERFORMANCE OF THIS ACTOR IN PROVIDING SECURITY?

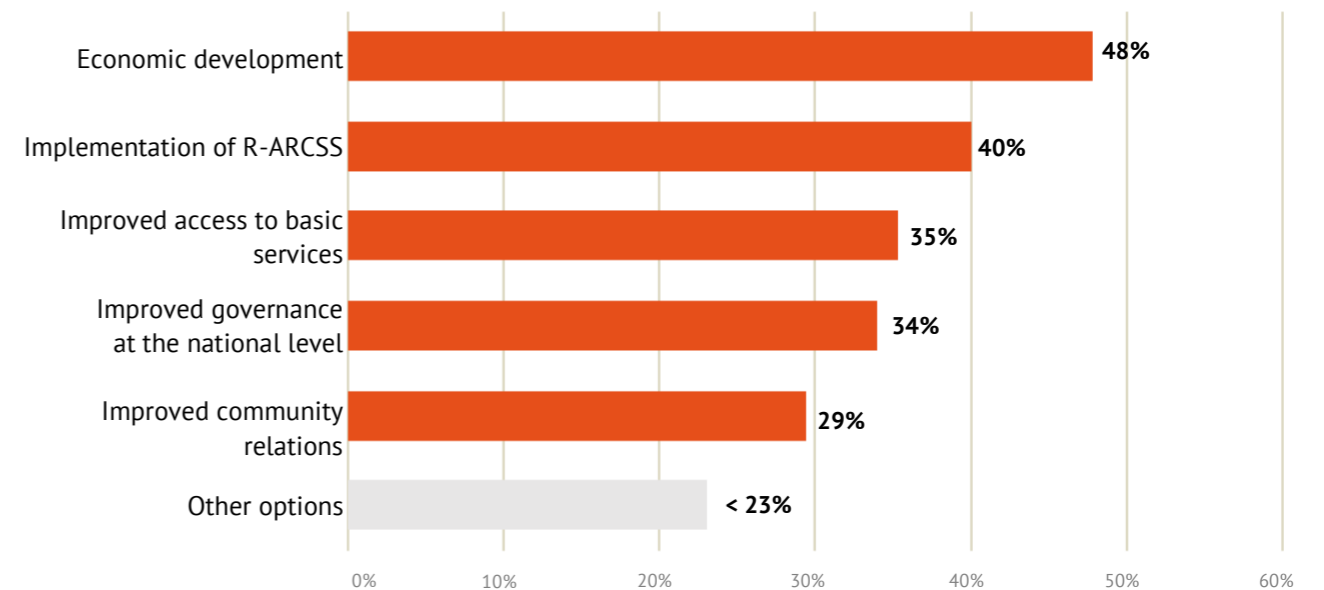

WHAT ARE THE MOST SIGNIFICANT CHANGES NEEDED TO BRING LASTING PEACE TO SOUTH SUDAN?





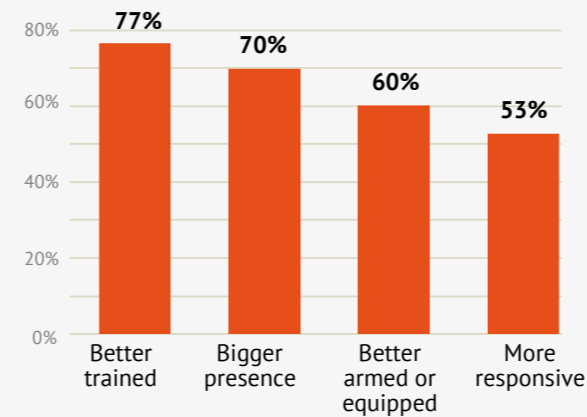

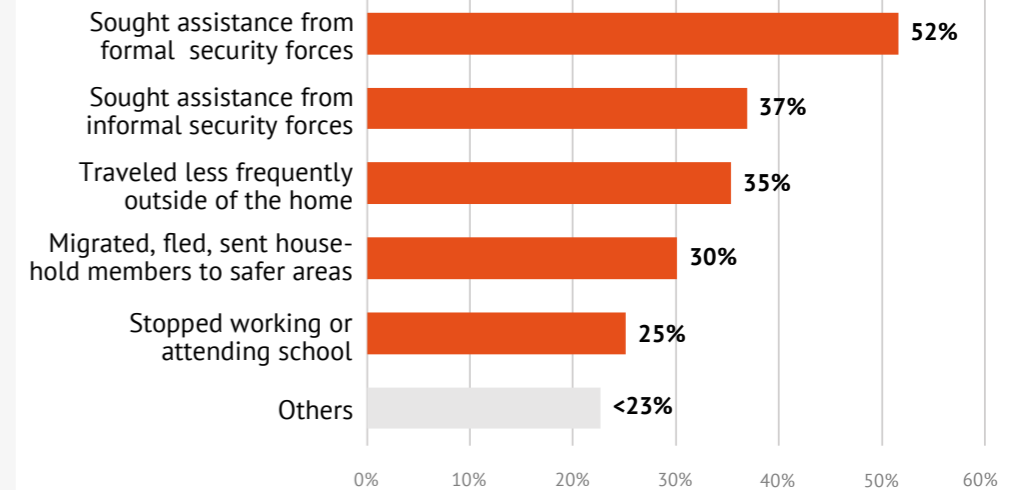

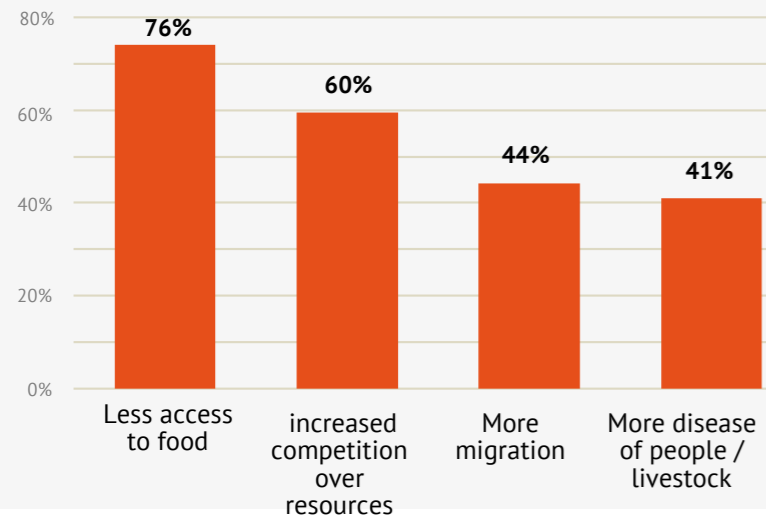

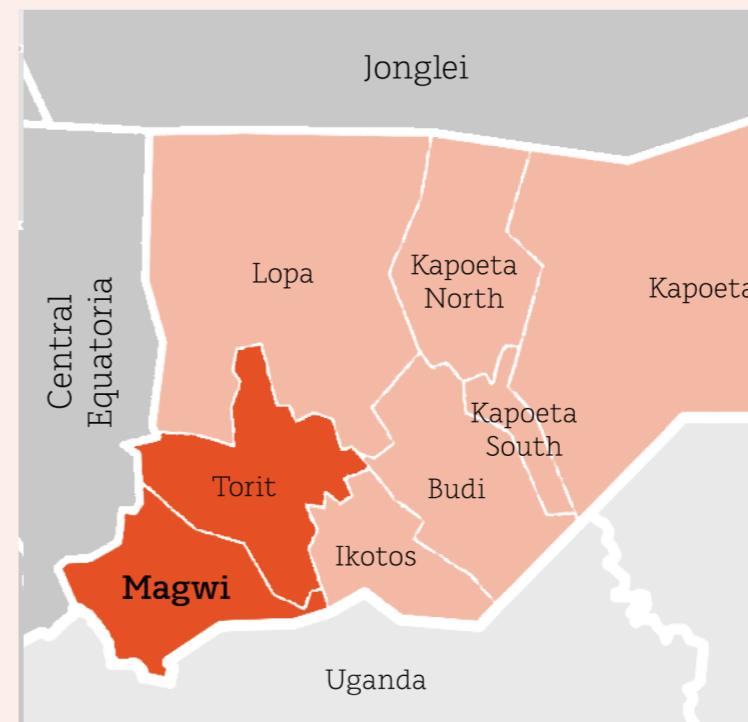
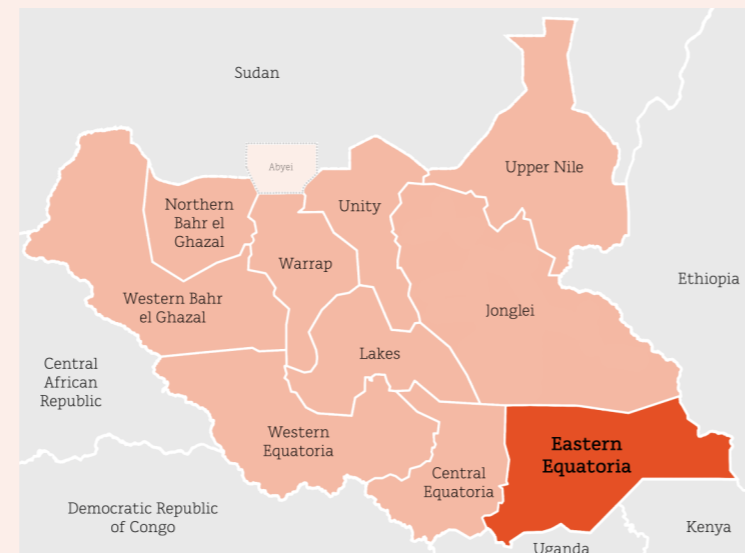

HUMAN SECURITY SURVEY METHODOLOGY

During 3 weeks in June 2022, **14** enumerators conducted **492** face-to-face interviews across 2 counties of Eastern Equatoria State using a standardized survey script. For more details on how HSS data is collected and analyzed, view our [methodological note](#).
