


LOCATION: COUNTY & PAYAM

The percentage of households reporting incidents has decreased since the previous survey round in 2022 [49%]. Total incidents reported have also decreased by 16.8% [80 less].



HUMAN SECURITY SURVEY METHODOLOGY

During 3 weeks in May 2023, 14 enumerators conducted 504 face-to-face interviews across 2 counties of Jonglei (Twic East County, Bor South County) using a standardized survey script. Enumerators were also deployed to Duk County, however severe road insecurity prevented data collection in the County this year. PAX will engage further with representatives from Twic East. Bor South, and Duk counties to present, validate and discuss the survey results, in order to formulate an action plan to improve the local security situation.
