






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
How do you rate the performance of this actor in providing security?












HAVE YOU OBSERVED ANY ENVIRONMENTAL CHANGES IN YOUR AREA IN THE LAST 12 MONTHS?








HUMAN SECURITY SURVEY METHODOLOGY

Over a period of 3 weeks in March 2023, **15** enumerators conducted **682** face-to-face interviews across all 4 districts of Kirkuk Governorate using a standardized survey script. For more details on how HSS data is collected and analysed, view our <u>methodological note</u>.

Taking into account the most recent population estimates, respondent targets were set with the aim of a representative distribution across gender, district, subdistrict, and urban/rural areas. Communities, households, and individual respondents were selected to participate through a systematic and approximately random procedure to increase the likelihood of generalizability.

The Iraqi Al-Amal Association (IAA), trusted long-time partner of PAX will continue its work in Kirkuk through community engagement activities with civilians, authorities, and a multitude of security actors to improve the local security situation using the results of the Human Security Survey.
